## Building a Godly Man Lesson 3 – The Father – Son Relationship

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*Introduction:* Fathers have a crucial role in the training up of their sons.

- A. The tragedy of this age is *the destruction of the father-son relationship*. (Heb 12:7-9)
  - 1. Many mothers are <u>never entering marriage or have been divorced</u>. In many communities the vast majority of boys do not live with their dads.
  - 2. Even when dad is in the home there is *little significant interaction* with his son.
  - 3. We are seeing multigeneration families with no fathers in the home. (Deut 5:9-10)
- B. There are *unique needs* that a son has in his upbringing.
  - 1. In the beginning he is close and <u>naturally attached to his mother</u>. (Prov 29:15; 30:17; 31:1)
  - 2. As he grows older, he naturally will <u>seek to grow closer to his father</u> and wants to learn to be a man! (**Prov 4:1-5**)

"A boy has an additional developmental task – to disidentify from his mother and identify with his father." – A Parents Guide to Preventing Homosexuality

#### I. Teach your sons to trust God

A. The essence of the fathers work with his sons is to "bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord." (Eph 6:4)

<u>Admonition</u> - teaching, admonition, warning, ethical and corrective instruction in regard to belief or behavior.

- 1. Teaching should include *all interactions with your sons*. In many ways these interactions teach him what God is like! (Ex 34:6-7)
- 2. A good teacher will seek to continually improve. There is also a humility that *seeks help and seeks greater wisdom*.
- 3. If we are to serve our sons, we must have a servant's heart! (Phil 2:3-4)
- 4. What happens with the father gets caught up *in pursuing idols*? (Col 3:5-6)
- B. Help your sons to *find "heroes" in the people of God*. One of those heroes will be you! (Jer 9:23-24)
  - 1. Our sons will know what we get excited about and what we want to know.
  - 2. How can the Bible become something more than external knowledge. Consider helping your sons *discuss and see Bible characters as real*!
  - 3. There also should be modern "heroes" of faith.
  - 4. There will be <u>needed intervention</u> when worldly heroes are sought after.
  - 5. What kind of opportunities are placed before us at the various stages of our sons lives? How do we *know if we are getting through*?

### II. Take the time to show and teach the courage to do what is right

- A. Men must develop <u>courage to stand and to lead</u>. (Josh 1:7; 23:6; 2 Chron 32:7-8)
  - 1. Men are wired <u>to be competitors and to fight</u>. That desire must be brought under the control and direction of the Lord!

- 2. Real courage that will stand in all circumstances <u>comes from the Lord</u>. (Ps 27:13-14; 31:21-24)
- 3. Godly men know the importance of <u>clearly identifying God's way</u> (principle) and boldly standing against the majority.
- B. What are some of the bedrock principles that must be found in a godly man?
  - 1. He must put others first.
  - 2. He must tell the truth.
  - 3. He must <u>refuse to participate</u> when others practice and approve of sin.
  - 4. He must come to work and earn his own way.
  - 5. He must give to those in need.
  - 6. He must .....
- C. Our sons must be tested and then be helped to learn from those tests.

#### (Ex 20:20; Deut 8:2; Jer 17:10; 20:12)

- 1. What is the difference between a temptation and a test?
- 2. One of the greatest mistakes parents make is to "rescue" their children from *important tests of faith*! (Ex. Conflicts between school, sports and church)
- 3. Here is where *our personal courage and wisdom* will be tested!
- 4. What does a successful test *look like*? (Jas 1:2-4; Rom 5:3-5)

### III. Teach your son to find fulfillment in work

- A. God's word directs *man to work and earn a living*. Work is honorable.
  - 1. God described creation as His "work." (Gen 2:2)
  - 2. Before the fall man was involved with work that involved <u>both physical labor</u> <u>and mental labor</u>. (Gen 2:15, 19-20)
  - 3. Afterwards God showed *the necessity of work and its difficulty*. (Gen 3:17-19)
- B. How did God's Son spend the majority of His life? (Mk 6:3)
  - 1. He received training from His father and was with him in that work.
  - 2. Jesus was around 30 years old when He began to preach!
- C. God directs us *to honest labor*. (Eph 4:28; 2 Thess 3:12; Lk 10:7)
  - 1. We can work for another and receive wages.
  - 2. We can have our own business by the principle of exchange (Buying and Selling) (Mt 13:44-45; Acts 16:14)
  - 3. We can invest and receive a share of a business. (Mt 25:27)
- D. What should be our attitude towards honorable work?
  - 1. The same as God! This is a matter of faithfulness. (2 Thess 3:10-12)
  - 2. When we work God is our boss. We should give our best! (Col 3:22-24)
  - 3. We can steal by failing to do our best.

# IV. Learn from your mistakes as a father and correct them quickly

- A. All parents will make mistakes. How <u>you handle mistakes</u> is an opportunity to teach! (Eph 4:32)
- B. We can show what it <u>really means to trust God</u>! (1 Pt 3:8-12)
